### **Approach to Capacity Building/Technical Assistance**

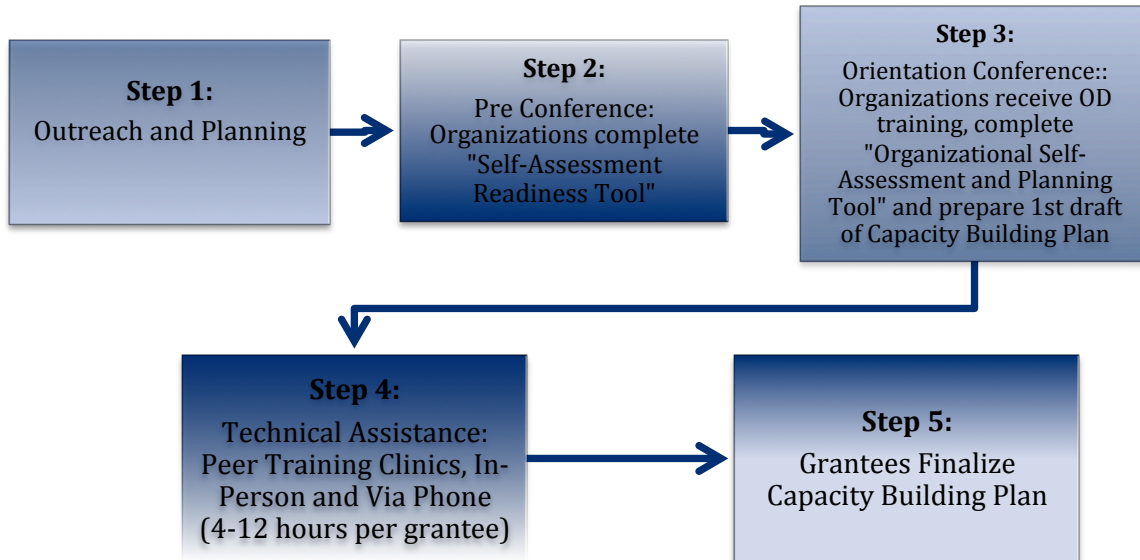
JLG, consultants and subcontractors will implement a transformative empowerment approach that helps organizations to meet the objectives:

- 1) Understand the elements of the CCF
- 2) Assess their organizational readiness and ability for capacity building, and
- 3) Create a detailed Capacity Development Plan (CBP).

To accomplish these goals, we will facilitate a 5-Step process that include assessments, training and technical assistance consultations. These integrated steps will help grantee organizations to engage in successful capacity building planning by:

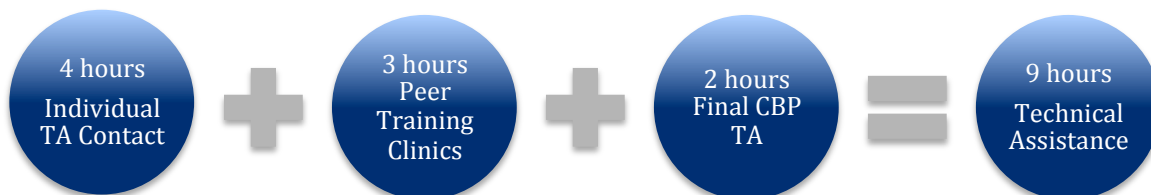
- ✓ determining the organization's readiness for change;
- ✓ increasing their knowledge in seven distinct priority capacity building areas;
- ✓ assessing leadership and organizational needs;
- ✓ creating a learning community and networking opportunities; and
- ✓ providing a roadmap toward improving organizational effectiveness and

achieving long-term sustainability.



### Individual TA Contact

After the completion of the Orientation and Training Day, the JLG Coordinator will assign a TA provider based on the feedback provided in the organizational assessments. Each organization will have at least 9 hours of technical assistance consultation to develop a capacity building plan.



### Peer Training Clinics

Additionally, the core team will design 1 hour peer training clinics covering the seven priority capacity building areas listed below. These clinics allow for continued learning and consistent grantee education and messaging as they



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approach the development of their CBP.

Purpose of Clinics:

- Deeper learning into priority areas
- Sharing information and resources
- Support of completion CBP in specialized priority areas
- Identification of technical assistance that will be need during the Phase 2-Implementation
